

Community Gardens Insurance Form (Please complete 1 form per gardener)

The City has taken a leadership role in working with an insurance broker to underwrite a policy for community gardeners that has not existed in the past. Through this policy, gardeners are adequately protected to participate in preparing and maintaining the garden. Now, they can play a more active role in using tools at the garden to make repairs and upgrades as needed.

1. The City of Kitchener provides mandatory insurance for community gardens on City-owned land.
2. Premiums of \$4.32 per plot and \$10.80 per community garden group must be paid in order for the insurance policy to become active. The City will cover these costs.
3. This insurance policy provides \$2 million in liability with \$500 deductible to be paid by the City in the unlikely event of a claim.
4. In order to retain insurance coverage and use of the community garden, Community Gardeners must follow the items prescribed in the Community Garden Agreement including Appendix A, The City's Rules for Garden Use.
5. The insurance policy covers your legal liability for bodily injury to or damage to property of others such as spectators, passersby, property owners and others resulting from your activity.
6. The liability policy **does not** provide benefits for medical expenses incurred as a result of an injury sustained by an insured member, while participating in a sanctioned insured activity.
7. The liability policy may protect you in the event of a lawsuit against claims of bodily injury or property damage.
8. Insurance coverage **only** applies to the activity and dates disclosed on the permit application.

10. **In order to participate in this community garden, all gardeners must provide the following information to the City. It will be used for insurance purposes only.**
